

The most common path to the award of Scottish Rite financial assistance for professional speech and language clinical treatment begins with a referral from a physician. Often the referral will be to a specific children's language clinic. Sometimes speech and language clinics are contacted directly without physician referral. That clinic will evaluate the child to determine whether speech and language therapy is appropriate and potentially beneficial for the child. If the clinic is willing and able to provide clinical treatment the subject of cost and payment requirements will arise. The Scottish Rite Children's Clinic has contracts for services with five private children's clinics in Billings which provide speech and language therapy for children. Sponsorships offered by Scottish Rite provide cost sharing for clinical treatment based on financial need. The five local speech and language clinic may refer parents (guardians) to Scottish Rite. They have the necessary forms. Parents (guardians) may also obtain the same forms directly from Scottish Rite or this website. In order to proceed it is necessary for one of the five designated clinics to have agreed to treat the child and one of its clinicians be willing sign a Treatment Plan.
